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**HON'BLE MR. JUSTICE KULDEEP MATHUR**

**Order**

**28/03/2026**

1. By way of filing the present writ petition, the petitioner  
has prayed for the following reliefs:-

*"It is, therefore, most humbly and respectfully prayed  
that this writ petition may kindly be allowed and;*

*1- The direction may kindly be passed to the respondents to  
terminate the pregnancy of the victim Miss X D/o Shri Pappu  
Singh in relation / continuation of the F.I.R. No. 71/2026,  
P.S. Bagri, District Pali; [Annex-1]*

*2- The respondents may kindly be directed to keep the DNA  
of the fetus preserved in relation to the charges of rape upon  
the accused.*

*3- That any other appropriate relief which this Hon'ble High Court deems just and proper may kindly be granted in favour of the petitioners.*

*4- Cost of the Writ Petition may kindly be awarded to the petitioners."*

2. Having heard the learned counsel for the parties and having perused the material available on record, this Court deems it just and proper to direct Superintendent, Bangar Hospital, District Pali to constitute a Medical Board forthwith in order to ascertain the gestational age of the foetus and to opine as to whether the termination of the pregnancy of the petitioner's daughter 'N' is medically safe or not within a period of 48 hours.

3. In case the Medical Board so constituted by Superintendent, Bangar Hospital, District Pali upon examination of the petitioner's daughter 'N' opines that the termination of the pregnancy is safe, then appropriate steps shall be taken for conducting the procedure to terminate pregnancy of the petitioner's daughter 'N' without any delay.

4. It is made clear that the DNA of the foetus shall be preserved and sent to concerned Forensic Science Laboratory for seven years. It is also made clear the entire procedure as indicated above shall be conducted in the presence of the SHO, Bagri Nagar, District Pali within a period of 48 hours.

5. With the aforesaid directions, the present writ petition as well as stay application stand disposed of.
