1. By way of filing the present writ petition, the petitioner has
prayed for the following reliefs:-

"It is therefore most respectfully prayed that this writ petition may kindly be allowed and by an appropriate writ, order or direction:-
1. The respondents may be directed to decide the representation given by the Petitioner immediately.
2. Kindly Restrict the private persons to encroach upon private land.
3. Any other appropriate order which this Hon'ble Court deems fit and proper in the facts and circumstances of the case, may also kindly be passed in favour of the petitioner."

2. After arguing the matter for some time, the petitioner who is present-in-person submitted that he would be satisfied if the competent authority of the respondent department is directed to consider and decide his representation in accordance with law as expeditiously as possible.

3. While considering the limited submission made at bar before this Court by the petitioner himself, this Court deems it just and proper to dispose of the present writ petition with liberty to the petitioner to file a fresh representation along with a certified copy of the order instant within a period of ten days before the office of competent authority of the respondent-department. In case the representation is so made, the competent authority of the respondent-department shall consider and decide the same in accordance with law as expeditiously as possible preferably within a period of 2 weeks from receipt thereof.

4. It is made clear that the aforesaid directions to decide representation only with a view to ensure expeditious redressal of the petitioners' grievance, and the same shall not be construed as a direction to decide the representation in a particular manner.

5. The present writ petition as well as the stay petition also stand disposed of.
