**HON'BLE MR. JUSTICE MUKESH RAJPUROHIT**

**Order**

**27/03/2026**

The instant appeals have been filed against the judgment and award dated 02.07.2013 passed by learned Judge, Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Pali in MAC Case No.40/2012 whereby the learned Tribunal has awarded a sum of Rs.3,27,000/- alongwith interest in favour of the appellants.

Learned counsel for the parties submit that they have amicably settled the dispute in the spirit of Lok Adalat and the insurance company has agreed to pay a further enhanced sum of Rs.8,00,000/- as a full and final settlement towards the

satisfaction of the award dated 02.07.2013 in addition to the amount already paid by the Insurance Company by the claimant(s).

Therefore, it is prayed that the present appeals may be disposed of in the light of the memo of understanding entered into between the parties.

In view of above, it is ordered that the above said enhanced amount of Rs.8,00,000/- shall be paid by the insurance company to the appellants within a period of two months from today. If the said amount is not paid by the insurance company within a period of two months, the insurance company shall pay interest @ 7% from today on the enhanced amount till the amount is actually paid to the appellants. Upon deposit of above amount, the trial Court is directed to deposit the entire amount in savings bank account of the claimants and not Fixed Deposit.

The appeals stand disposed of in above terms. The memorandum of understanding is taken on record.

Stay petition and all pending applications, if any, also stand disposed of.

The Registry is directed to send back the record, if any, forthwith.
