The present interim bail application under Section 483 of BNSS (439 Cr.P.C.) has been filed by the petitioner on the ground that his own marriage is to be solemnised on 12.04.2025. A copy of marriage invitation card has also been placed on record.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as the petitioner himself is to get married, his presence for the marriage ceremonies is essential. It is therefore, prayed that the petitioner may be released on interim bail for a period of 30 days.

Learned Public Prosecutor has not disputed the factum of marriage of the petitioner.

Looking to the totality of facts and circumstances of the case, a humanitarian approach is required to be adopted, thus, this Court deems it just and proper to enlarge the petitioner on interim bail for a period of 30 days.

Accordingly, the interim bail application filed under Section 483 of BNSS (439 Cr.P.C.) is allowed and it is directed that petitioner **Ashok S/o Punaram** arrested in connection with F.I.R. No.20/2021, registered at Police Station Bhopalgarh, District Jodhpur (Rural), for the offences under Sections 8/15 and 29 of the NDPS Act; Sections 307 and 379/411 of IPC and Sections 3/25

of the Arms Act, be released on interim bail for a period of **thirty (30) days**, subject to the condition that he shall deposit a sum of **Rs.5,00,000/-** before the trial Court and provided he furnishes a personal bond in a sum of **Rs.4,00,000/-** with two sound and solvent sureties in the sum of **Rs.2,00,000/- (out of which one surety will be a close relative of the petitioner)** each to the satisfaction of learned trial court for his surrender on completion of 30 days from the date of actual release.

If the petitioner surrenders within the stipulated period before the concerned Jail, then the amount of Rs.5,00,000/- so deposited before the trial court shall be refunded back to him whereas if the petitioner fails to surrender within the stipulated period, then the amount so deposited shall be forfeited immediately.

Let this bail application be again listed on 02.06.2025. Learned Public Prosecutor shall be required to submit the compliance report of the order as to whether the petitioner has surrendered or not.
