1. The instant writ petition has been preferred giving challenge to the judgment and decree dated 18.08.2023 passed by the learned Additional District Judge, Gulabpura in Civil Original Case No.2/2018, whereby the suit filed by the petitioner has been dismissed and the decree was prepared accordingly.
2. Any challenge to a judgment and decree passed by a civil court in civil original suit can be made by way of filing an appeal under Section 96 read with Order 41 of the CPC.

3. An application has been moved seeking conversion of the instant writ petition into an appeal. The format of both appeal and the writ petition are different besides there would be a question of limitation as well. There are protocols of filing a civil first appeal.

4. In this view of the matter, the writ petition is disposed of. The stay petition is also disposed of. The petitioner is given liberty to make a challenge to the judgment and decree dated 18.08.2023 by way of filing a civil regular first appeal. If he desires, he may be given back certified copy of the judgment annexed with the writ petition after replacing the same by a xerox copy of the same in the record.
