The present Criminal Miscellaneous Petition seeking quashing of FIR No. 416/2024 registered at Police Station Purani Mandi, District Sriganganagar, for offences under Sections 115(2), 126(2), 109(1), 191(3) and 190 of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita (BNS), qua the petitioner.

The contention of learned counsel for the petitioner is that the petitioner is not involved in the alleged offence and has been falsely implicated. It is submitted that though the petitioner has been shown as a conspirator during investigation, the investigation qua him is still pending.

This Court has considered the contents of the FIR, wherein the petitioner has been specifically named as a conspirator.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has also drawn the attention of this Court to the status of the investigation, wherein he has been shown as a conspirator.

This Court has considered the averments made in the petition as well as the documents available on record. The Hon'ble Apex Court, in recent judgments, has consistently held that the investigating agency has the statutory right to conduct investigation and that such investigation should not be throttled at a premature stage.

In the present case, since the investigation is still pending and the involvement of the petitioner has surfaced during investigation, this Court does not find any ground to interfere in the exercise of its inherent powers under Section 482 CrPC.

Accordingly, the present Criminal Miscellaneous Petition is dismissed.

However, it is clarified that the observations made herein shall not prejudice the rights of the petitioner in any other proceedings and shall not affect the merits of the case at any subsequent stage.

All pending application(s), if any, stand disposed of.
