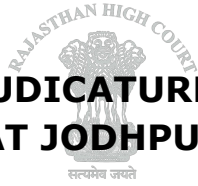

1. Learned counsel for the petitioner, at the outset, submits that the petitioner may be permitted to submit a fresh representation before the respondent No.2- Director, Elementary Education, Education Department, Lalgah Palace Near Unnamed Road, Samta Nagar, Bikaner and the said respondent may be directed to decide the said representation within a particular time frame.

2. In view of the submissions made hereinabove, this Court deems it appropriate to direct the petitioner to submit fresh representation before the respondent No.2- Director, Elementary Education, Education Department, Lalgah Palace Near Unnamed Road, Samta Nagar, Bikaner within a period of '7 days' from today and the respondent No.2- Director, Elementary Education, Education Department, Lalgah Palace Near Unnamed Road, Samta Nagar, Bikaner, is directed to decide the representation by way of passing a speaking order, strictly in accordance with law within a period of 'four weeks' from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

3. With the aforesaid directions, the writ petition is disposed of. Stay application as well as all other pending applications, if any, also stand disposed of accordingly.

4. It is made clear that aforesaid direction to decide the representation has been issued only with a view to ensure expeditious redressal of petitioner's grievance. The same may not be construed to be an order to decide the representation in a particular manner.
