1. The instant writ petition has been moved on behalf of the petitioner precisely averring that he remained absent from his duty since 20.02.2024 and whereafter presented himself to join the duty back in the month of April, 2024 itself. However, neither he was permitted to join nor any action was taken against him and even no notice was served to show cause of his absence.
2. The grievance of the petitioner had been that even after lapse of one year he received no instructions or directions by the higher authorities and as such the petitioner has been left in lurch

and limbo and thus, he had left with no other option but to approach this Court for redressal of his grievances.

3. Vide order dated 02.05.2025, a Coordinate Bench of this Court had directed the respondent authorities to permit the petitioner to join his Office if he keeps himself present before them.

4. Shri Tanuj Jain appearing on behalf of learned AGC Mr. Mukesh Dave at the outset, stated to this Court that the compliance of the order dated 02.05.2025 has been made and the petitioner has been taken back at his job. It is however, informed to this Court that till now, no department proceedings has been instituted against him.

5. Since the relief claimed for has been granted and the grievances of the petitioner has been ventilated, nothing survives for this Court to consider further in the matter, the writ petition is disposed of.

6. The petitioner who has been allowed to join shall continue his Office. In case, the respondents wishes to institute any proceedings against him in accordance with law, they are free to do so.

7. Stay petition also stands disposed of.
