HON'BLE MR. JUSTICE MUKESH RAJPUROHIT**Order****10/07/2026**

1. These writ petitions under Article 226 of the Constitution of India have been preferred, in sum and substance, with the following prayers and for the sake of convenience, the prayer clause is being taken from the lead case i.e. S.B. Civil Writ Petition No.. 7877/2024, which reads as under:-

(i) The impugned order/letter dated 24.03.2017 (Ann.4) and letter dated 22.04.2024 (Ann.10) vide No.LPSS-JKG;2024-25/20 passed by Principal of school i.e. respondent No.4 concerned may kindly be declared illegal, arbitrary and unjust and same may kindly be quashed and set aside.

(ii) the respondents No.1 to 3 and 5 may kindly be directed to instruct respondent No.4 to allow the petitioners/child continue in the same school for further study i.e. class 9 to 12 and without charging any kind of fee from the petitioners for 9 to 12 class as per norms of RTE Act, 2009.

(iii) Any other appropriate writ, order or direction which this Hon'ble Court deems just and proper may kindly be passed in favour of the petitioners."

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that in pursuance of the interim orders dated 15.05.2024 and 08.05.2024, passed by a Coordinate Bench of this Court, the petitioners have completed their course of 9 to 12 class in the respondent-school. Hence, the writ petitions have become infructuous.

3. Mr. Manish Sisodia, learned Sr. Advocate, assisted by Mr. Deepesh Birla, learned counsel for the respondent No.4 - Lakshmipath Singhania School does not dispute the aforesaid facts. He, however, seeks a liberty to raise their demand for recovery of school fee, if any, by way of filing application before the State Government.

4. In view of the submissions made by learned counsel for the parties, these writ petitions are dismissed as having rendered infructuous. However, it is open for the respondent No.4 - Lakshmipath Singhania School to take appropriate remedy for recovery of the due school fee in respect of the petitioners-students from the State Government.

5. Stay applications and all pending applications, if any, also stand disposed of.
