1. The instant bail applications have been filed by the petitioners under Section 483 BNSS who have been arrested in connection with the FIR No.40/2026 dated 14.04.2026 registered at the Police Station Churu Sadar, District Churu, for the offences under Sections 8/20 & 29 of the NDPS Act.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have been falsely implicated in the present case while alleging that contraband Ganja weighing 9.527 Kgs was recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioners – Govind and Malam Singh and the said contraband was supplied by the

petitioner - Shankarlal. He submits that the contraband recovered weighs well below the commercial quantity and that the petitioners have no previous criminal antecedents. Thus, the petitioners deserve to be enlarged on bail.

3. Per contra, learned Public Prosecutor opposes the bail application, however, is not in a position to refute the fact that the contraband recovered is below commercial quantity and petitioners have no previous criminal antecedents.

4. Having considered the submissions advanced at Bar by learned counsel for the parties and having regard to the entirety of facts and circumstances of the case as available on record; and looking to the fact that trial may take a long time to conclude and, without expressing any opinion on the merits/demerits of the case, this Court deems it fit to enlarge the petitioners on bail.

5. Consequently, the bail applications are allowed. It is ordered that the accused petitioners **(1) Shankarlal S/o Sultanaram, (2) Govind S/o Sharwan & (3) Malam Singh S/o Hukam Singh** arrested in connection with FIR No.40/2026 dated 14.04.2026 registered at the Police Station Churu Sadar, District Churu, shall be released on bail; provided they furnishes a personal bond in the sum of Rs.50,000/- each and two sureties of Rs.25,000/- each to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court, with a stipulation to appear before that Court on all dates of hearing and as and when called upon to do so.
