Issue notice.

Mr. Sandeep Soni associate to Mr. B.L. Bhati, AAG is directed to accept notice on behalf of respondents. Service upon respondents is therefore, complete.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that the vehicle, Tata SFC 407, purchased by the petitioners was converted into a mini bus (passenger vehicle) by the competent authority, RTO Ujjain, M.P. under the relevant provisions of Motor Vehicle

Act, 1988. Learned counsel further submitted that the vehicle in question, having Chassis No. MAT505261H8G11992 & MAT505261H8G13553 and Engine No. 4SPCR11FSY618421 & 4SPCR11GSY622826, was not allowed to be plied on city roads by the respondents–Transport Department.

Learned counsel further submitted that, to the utter disbelief and surprise of the petitioner, the District Transport Officer-I, without affording any opportunity of hearing to the petitioner, vide order dated 12.05.2025, has declared the vehicle in question as “Not to be Transacted” (NTBT). It was submitted that admittedly, the order passed by the RTO, Ujjain (M.P.), converting the Tata SFC 407 into a mini bus (passenger vehicle) has neither been cancelled nor withdrawn by the competent authority; therefore, the impugned order dated 12.05.2025 ought not to have been passed by the District Transport Officer-I, Jodhpur.

The matter requires consideration.

Issue notice.

Issue notice of the stay application as well.

In the meanwhile and until further orders, the effect and operation of the office order dated 12.05.2025 passed by the District Transport Officer, declaring the vehicle in question bearing Registration No. RJ-58-PA-0349 & RJ-58-PA-0344 as “Not to be Transacted” (NTBT), shall remain stayed. The respondents shall not create any hindrance in the petitioner’s use of the said vehicle as a mini bus.
