Heard on application filed by the petitioner for seeking correction in order dated 22.04.2026.

It is stated by learned counsel that on 22.04.2026, learned counsel for the petitioner sought permission to withdraw this petition with liberty to file fresh writ petition. Learned counsel submits that in the concluding line of the order dated 22.04.2026, although, it has been mentioned that the writ petition was dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for, but kind of liberty granted by this Court is missing.

Learned counsel submits that earlier writ petition was withdrawn by the petitioner only with a view to file fresh petition with better particulars, which was also permitted by this Court, but as the nature of liberty sought by the petitioner is not mentioned in the order dated 22.04.2026, it may cause prejudice to the petitioner.

For the reasons mentioned in the application, the same is allowed.

Order dated 22.04.2026 is modified and corrected to the extent that first para shall be read as under:

"After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner, on instructions, seeks permission to withdraw the writ petition with liberty to file fresh."

Accordingly, application stands disposed of. This order shall be considered as part and parcel of order dated 22.04.2026.
