1. The matter comes up on an application filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India read with Section 528 of BNSS (IA No.03/2026) on behalf of the petitioner seeking extension of the interim/temporary bail granted by this Court vide order dated 19.08.2025 and extended vide order dated 17.10.2025, 16.12.2025 & 12.03.2026 passed in S.B. Criminal Writ Petition No. 1269/2025, on the ground of post operative care of his mother and has prayed for extension of temporary bail for a period of four months' for the said purpose.

2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Public Prosecutor.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner had previously been granted interim bail to facilitate the surgery and post-operative care of his mother. He further submits that, as

per the medical report annexed with the application, the total knee replacement surgery of the petitioner's mother could not be performed due to her low haemoglobin level and the treating doctor advised improvement of her haemoglobin level before undertaking the surgery. He further submits that the total knee replacement surgery has now been scheduled for 20.06.2026. It is also submitted that the petitioner is the only available person and the sole caretaker responsible for providing necessary care and assistance to his mother during the aforesaid surgery and the subsequent recovery period.

4. Vide order dated 26.05.2026, this Court directed the learned Public Prosecutor to procure the medical report of the petitioner's mother. Today, the learned Public Prosecutor has produced the report dated 11.06.2026, forwarded by the SHO, Police Station Kotwali, Sirohi, along with the relevant medical documents. The report reflects that the total knee replacement surgery of the petitioner's mother has now been fixed for 20.06.2026. The said report is taken on record.

5. Learned Public Prosecutor has opposed the prayer for grant of temporary/interim bail; however, he is not in a position to dispute the fact that the petitioner's mother has already undergone spinal surgery and is presently required to undergo knee replacement surgery.

6. Having regard to the overall facts and circumstances of the case and upon careful consideration of the material available on record, particularly the fact that the total knee replacement surgery of the petitioner's mother is scheduled for 20.06.2026, this Court deems it appropriate to extend the interim

bail/temporary bail of the petitioner for a further period of **90 days**.

7. In this background and for humanitarian grounds and there being no legal impediment to extend the period of interim bail/temporary, the instant application is allowed and the period of interim bail already granted to the convict-petitioner **Rahul Modi S/o Late Virendra Modi**, by this Court, vide order *ibid*, is hereby extended for further **90 days** on the same conditions/directions and the bail bonds furnished by him in terms of the order dated 19.08.2025 passed in S.B. Criminal Writ Petition No.1269/2025.

7.1. It is made clear that the instant order shall be applicable qua all the FIRs, the recital of which has been given in the present petition.

8. Learned Public Prosecutor is directed to procure the status report/case diary/factual report with regard to the surrender of the petitioner before the Jail Authorities by the next date of hearing.

9. List the matter on 22.09.2026.
