1. The application (IA No.02/2025) has been filed seeking extension of the interim/temporary bail granted by this Court vide order dated 19.08.2025 passed in S.B. Criminal Writ Petition No. 1269/2025, on the ground of the petitioner's mother's spine surgery, and has, therefore, prayed for extension of temporary bail for the said purpose.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that earlier the petitioner was granted interim bail, in which, the petitioner was enlarged on interim bail for a period of 60 days. However, due to certain complications, the doctor advised that after the spinal surgery, the surgery of knee replacement can take place. It is submitted that as per the latest medical report dated 15.10.2025,

the spinal surgery of the petitioner's mother is scheduled for 23.10.2025. It is also submitted that the petitioner is the only person and the sole caretaker available to provide due care and assistance to his mother, who has to undergo surgery.

3. Vide order dated 14.10.2025 passed by this Court, the learned Public Prosecutor was directed to procure the medical report of the petitioner's mother. Today, the learned Public Prosecutor has produced the said medical report, which reflects that the surgery of spine of petitioner's mother is scheduled on 23.10.2025. The said report is taken on record.

4. Learned Public Prosecutor has opposed the prayer for grant of temporary/interim bail; however, he is not in a position to dispute the fact that the petitioner's mother is scheduled to undergo surgery for spine on 23.10.2025.

5. After considering the overall facts and circumstances of the case and upon careful perusal of the material available on record, this Court deems it appropriate to extend the interim bail/temporary bail of the petitioner for a further period of 60 days.

6. In this background and for humanitarian grounds and there being no legal impediment to extend the period of interim bail/temporary, the instant application is allowed and the period of interim bail already granted to the convict-petitioner **Rahul Modi S/o Late Virendra Modi**, by this Court, vide order *ibid*, is hereby extended for 60 days' on the same conditions/directions and the bail and bonds furnished by him/her in terms of the order dated 19.08.2025 passed in S.B. Criminal Writ Petition No. 1269/2025.



7. Learned Public Prosecutor is directed to procure the status report/case diary/factual report with regard to the surrender of the petitioner before the Jail Authorities by the next date of hearing.

8. List the matter on 18.12.2025.
