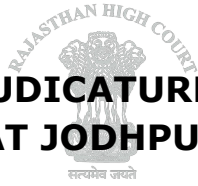

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he does not wish to press the present criminal miscellaneous petition. However, he seeks liberty for the petitioner to submit a representation before the concerned Investigating Officer, considering the facts and circumstances of the present case.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that there are no specific allegations against the petitioner and that, as per the contents of the FIR itself, it is stated that the petitioner had handed over the amount to Ramesh.

Accordingly, the present criminal miscellaneous petition is dismissed as not pressed, with liberty granted to the petitioner to submit a detailed representation before the concerned Investigating Officer, incorporating all the grounds raised in the present petition, within a period of seven (07) days from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

In the event such a representation is submitted, the concerned Investigating Officer shall consider and decide the same minutely, objectively, and in accordance with law. All relevant documents submitted along with the representation shall also be duly taken into consideration.

It is further directed that, for a period of ten (10) days from the date of filing of the representation, the petitioner shall not be arrested in connection with FIR No. 423/2025 registered at Police Station Sanchore, District Jalore.

All pending application(s), if any, stand disposed of.
