1. The present misc. application has been filed by the petitioner seeking waiver of the condition of furnishing two surety bonds in pursuance of the order dated 13.02.2026 passed by this Court in S.B. Criminal Miscellaneous Bail Application No. 2002/2026.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner comes from a downtrodden society and there is no other family member in his family, who can furnish the surety bonds in favour of the petitioner for his release on bail. He further submits that the financial condition of the petitioner's family is quite indigent. He, therefore, prays that the present misc. application may be allowed and the petitioner may be enlarged on bail in pursuance of

the order dated 13.02.2026 without insisting for furnishing two surety bonds as ordered in the aforesaid order.

3. Learned Public Prosecutor while producing a report dated 04.06.2026, submits that the petitioner comes from lower rung of the society and the condition of the petitioner's family is very poor.

4. Having considered the submissions made before this Court and a perusal of the report dated 04.06.2026, it reveals that the condition of the petitioner's family is indigent and there is no other capable family member in his family, who can furnish the surety bonds for his release on bail. In this view of the matter, this Court is of the considered view that ends of justice will be met if the order dated 13.02.2026, qua the petitioner, is modified to the extent that the petitioner shall be enlarged on bail on furnishing the personal bond and without insisting for furnishing the two surety bonds.

6. Ordered accordingly.

7. The present misc. application is disposed of in the above terms.
