1. Instant second bail application has been filed by petitioner under Section 483 of BNSS in connection with FIR No. 406/2024 registered at Police Station- Pilibanga, District- Hanumangarh for offence under Sections 8/21 and 29 of the NDPS Act.
2. It has been pointed out that the contraband was recovered from the possession of Shamsheer Singh and Jasdeep Singh, and on their statements, petitioner was made accused in the present case with the aid of Section 29 of the NDPS Act. Petitioner is in custody since 15.07.2024. After investigation, charge-sheet has been filed, but thereafter there is no progress in the criminal trial and not a single witness from the prosecution has been examined. It has further been submitted that, considering the fact that speedy trial is an integral facet of the right to life and personal liberty, co-accused Jasdeep Singh has



been enlarged on bail vide order dated 21.04.2026 passed in Criminal Misc. Second Bail Application No. 4802/2026, and co-accused Shamsher Singh has also been enlarged on bail vide order dated 07.05.2026 passed in Criminal Misc. Second Bail Application No. 5354/2026. Therefore, in such circumstances, petitioner may also be released on bail.

3. Learned Public Prosecutor has opposed the bail application.
4. Heard counsel for petitioner as well as learned Public Prosecutor and perused the material available on record.
5. Having considered the overall facts and circumstances of the case and the fact that petitioner is in custody since 15.07.2024 and progress of trial in the present criminal case has not progressed, due to which fundamental right of life and liberty of petitioner, enshrined under Article 21 of the Constitution of India, is being infringed; there are no criminal antecedents of petitioner; other co-accused, namely, Shamsher Singh and Jasdeep Singh have already been released on bail, but without commenting on merits of the case, this Court deems it just and proper to release the petitioner on bail.
6. Accordingly, the second bail application is allowed and it is ordered that the accused-petitioner **Binder Singh Alias Bhinder Singh S/o Chinder Singh** shall be released on bail provided he furnishes a personal bond in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with two sureties of Rs.25,000/- each, out of which one should be local surety as the petitioner is resident of State of Punjab, to the satisfaction of the learned trial Judge for his appearance before the court concerned on all the dates of hearing as and when called upon to do so.
