1. These bail applications under Section 483 of BNSS are filed by the applicants-accused **1. Mangi Lal S/o Omprakash,**
2. Mahendra Nath S/o Khiyanath seeking bail in respect



of a criminal case registered as FIR No.64/2026 dated 23.04.2026 registered at P.S. Sahwa, District - Churu, for the offence under Sections 318(4), 316(2), 61(2) of BNS and Section 66D of I.T. (Amendment) Act, 2008.

2. Learned counsel for the applicants submits that the applicants have been falsely implicated in the matter and the investigation against them is complete and they are no more required in investigation. He further submits that there are no chance of fleeing of applicant accused from the jurisdiction of this Hon'ble Court. The applicants do not have any criminal antecedents. He also submits that the applicants undertakes not to repeat offence and cooperate with investigation/trial, which will take time.
3. Learned counsel for the applicants submits that a police official has lodged a report but no complainant or victim has appeared before the police to prove allegation of cheating and fraud with him. He also submitted that only on the basis of complaint on portal the petitioners were arrested by police on 23.04.2026 / 30.04.2026. He also submitted that except one case against Mahendra Nath there is no criminal antecedent against the petitioners and charge-sheet has already been filed.
4. Learned Public Prosecutor has vehemently opposed the bail applications and submitted that the allegations are grave and serious in nature.
5. Heard learned counsel for the parties and learned Public Prosecutor. Perused the material placed on record by both the parties.



6. Complainant Somvir ASI, P.S. Sahwa, District Churu in a special campaign mule hunter has analyzed bank account details of both the petitioners and on basis of alleged crime committed by them lodged FIR No.64/2026 at Police Station Sahwa, District Churu for offence under Sections 318(4), 316(2), 61(2) of BNS and Section 66D of IT (Amendment) Act, 2008. Both the petitioners were arrested on 23.04.2026 / 30.04.2026 respectively and after investigation police has already filed a charge-sheet. Except one case of accident against Mahendra Nath there is no criminal antecedent against the petitioners. The offence relating to cyber crime that too against a private individual but the case has been lodged and analyzed by the police on their own. The authority of police required to be examined by the trial Court at the time of consideration of framing of charge and also at the time of final adjudication.
7. Upon hearing the arguments and perusing the record, we have found that the applicants-accused are no more required in the investigation and they are in custody for quite some time. The further proceedings will take its own time, therefore, looking to entirety of facts and circumstances of the case and without expressing any opinion on merits of the case, the Court deems it appropriate to grant bail to the applicants-accused.
8. Thus, the instant bail applications filed on behalf of applicants-accused **1. Mangi Lal S/o Omprakash,** **2. Mahendra Nath S/o Khiyanath,** are hereby allowed and the applicants-accused are ordered to be released on



bail with condition that each of the petitioner would furnish a personal bond of ₹50,000/- with two sureties of like amount to the satisfaction of the Trial Court with the following conditions:-

- (i) The applicants-accused shall not tamper with evidence or influence the witness in any manner.
- (ii) The applicants-accused shall not indulge in any criminal activity and shall not repeat any criminal offence punishable under the Law.
- (iii) The applicants-accused shall attend the hearing of the Trial Court on the date fixed by the Trial court or as and when asked to appear before the Trial Court.
- (iv) In case of any violation of above conditions, the bail granted to the applicants-accused shall be liable to be canceled.
