This applications for bail under Section 483 of BNSS have
been filed by the petitioners who have been arrested in connection
with F.I.R. No.226/2026 registered at Police Station Hanumangarh
Junction, District Hanumangarh for offences under Sections
331(4), 305(A), 317(2) and 3(5) of BNS.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioners as also learned Public Prosecutor and perused the material available on record.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that in the present case, offences pressed against the petitioners are triable by the Court of Magistrate and after investigation, charge-sheet has been filed. The petitioners Sandeep Singh and Jitendra Kumar are in judicial custody since 12.04.2026 respectively. It is further stated that although there are several cases against them nevertheless, the trial of the case is going on and they have not been convicted, therefore, the benefit of bail may be granted to the accused-petitioners.

Per contra, learned Public Prosecutor has opposed the bail application.

This Court has considered the rival submissions, facts and circumstances of the case, keeping in view of the fact that conclusion of the trial of the case is likely to take time and the prosecution has not shown any apprehension of the petitioners fleeing away from justice, in case they are enlarged on bail; but, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I deem it just and proper to grant bail to the petitioners under Section 483 of BNSS.

Consequently, the bail applications under Section 483 of BNSS is allowed. It is ordered that the accused-petitioners **1. Sandeep Singh Alias Sukhdeep Singh Alias Silu S/o Hansa Singh and 2. Jitendra Kumar Alias Bholu S/o Mahendra** arrested in connection with F.I.R. No.226/2026 registered at Police

Station Hanumangarh Junction, District Hanumangarh, shall be released on bail, if not wanted in any other case, provided each of them furnishes a personal bond of Rs.50,000/- and two sureties of Rs.25,000/- each, to the satisfaction of learned trial court, for their appearance before that court on each & every date of hearing and whenever called upon to do so till completion of the trial.
