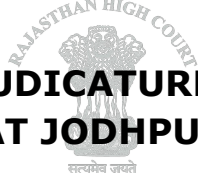

HON'BLE MR. JUSTICE FARJAND ALI

Order

1. The instant writ petition has been preferred by the petitioner with the grievance that despite the interim protection granted by the competent Civil Court in respect of the suit property, the official respondents were allegedly proposing to interfere with the petitioner's possession and to initiate proceedings for removal of the alleged encroachment.

2. In compliance of the order dated 03.07.2026 passed by this Court, Mr. Ravi Kumar, Tehsildar, Jahajpur, District Bhilwara, is present before this Court along with learned counsel appearing for the State. The Tehsildar submits and assures this Court that till the final disposal of the civil suit pending before the competent Civil Court and so long as the interim stay order passed therein remains operative, the official respondents shall not interfere with the suit property in any manner, including by issuance of any notice or by taking any action for removal of the alleged encroachment.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in view of the aforesaid statement and assurance, the grievance raised in the present writ petition stands redressed.

4. In view of the statement made by the Tehsildar, which is taken on record, nothing further survives for consideration in the present writ petition. The Tehsildar shall remain bound by the aforesaid assurance and, in the event of any breach thereof, shall be liable for a contemptuous situation.

5. Accordingly, the writ petition is disposed of. All pending applications also stand disposed of.
