Learned counsel for the appellant submitted that despite there being reservation for women, the appellant was not granted appointment in pursuance of the advertisement dated 29.10.2021 issued for the post of Constable-Driver. It was submitted that the appellant had applied for the post of Female Constable-Driver in the TSP area of District Banswara.

2. Learned counsel for the appellant sought to impress upon the Court that the appellant possessed a valid driving licence and, therefore, she ought to have been granted appointment against the women quota considering her driving skills. However, it remains unrefuted that the appellant failed to qualify the driving proficiency test.

3. This Court finds that the sole reason for dismissal of the appeal is that the appellant did not qualify the mandatory driving proficiency test, which is an essential qualification for the post of Driver. In absence of qualifying the said proficiency test, further consideration of the appellant's candidature was not permissible.

4. Accordingly, this Court is in complete agreement with the conclusion arrived at by the learned Single Judge. The present appeal is hereby dismissed.
