Learned counsel for the petitioner *inter-alia* contends that in complete misuse and abuse of the provisions contained under Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 without verifying the facts the FIR in question has been registered.

Notwithstanding, that neither the presence of the petitioner accused is borne out at the time of incidence which has been complained of nor is there any witness to the so called abuses hurled on the complainant.

Further argues that the genesis of the dispute in reality is that the son of the complainant was working as a class-IV employee with the Village Development Committee and owing to certain irregularities committed by him his services were terminated.

Further argues that the FIR in question has been registered to put collateral pressure to take the complainant son back in service notwithstanding his delinquency.

Issue notice.

Mr. Gaurav Singh, learned Public Prosecutor accepts notice for respondent No.1. Issue notice to respondents No.2 only.

Meanwhile, no coercive steps shall be taken against the petitioner in connection with the FIR No.148/2024 dated 04.04.2024 registered at Police Station Tibbi, District Hanumangarh under Section 3(1) (s)) of SC/ST Act, however they shall join investigation as and when summoned by the I.O.
