The present interim bail application has been filed by the petitioner on the ground of illness of his wife.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the wife of the petitioner has a lump in her uterus, which needs to be operated immediately as advised by the Doctor. There is no one in the family to take care of the wife of the petitioner. Therefore, it is prayed that the petitioner may be released on interim bail for a period of 30 days.

In compliance of the directions of this Court, learned Public Prosecutor has verified the fact regarding the illness of the petitioner's wife. However, he opposed the prayer for interim bail as the petitioner has committed offence under POCSO Act.

Taking into consideration the facts that the wife of the petitioner is suffering from uterus problem and she has been advised for urgent operation and there is no one in the family to

take care of the wife of the petitioner, this Court deems it just and proper to grant interim bail to the petitioner for a period of 30 days.

Accordingly, the interim bail application filed under Sec.483 of BNSS is allowed and it is directed that the petitioner Jesa Ram Pandar S/o Shri Nemaram arrested in connection with FIR No.402/2023, P.S. Ladnun, District Nagaur for offences under Section 363, 366(A), 376, 376(D) of IPC and Section 5(g)/6 of POCSO Act, be released on interim bail for a period of 30 days, subject to the condition that he shall deposit a sum of Rs.1 lakh before the trial court and provided he furnishes a personal bond in a sum of Rs.4,00,000/- with two sound and solvent sureties in the sum of Rs.2,00,000/- each to the satisfaction of learned trial court for his surrender on completion of 30 days period from the date of his release. One surety should be furnished by a close relative of the petitioner.

If the petitioner surrenders within the stipulated period before the concerned Jail, then the amount of Rs.1 lakh so deposited before the trial court shall be refunded back to him and if the petitioner fails to surrender within the stipulated period, then the amount so deposited shall be forfeited immediately.

Let this bail application be again listed on 08.09.2025, and on that date, learned Public Prosecutor and learned counsel for the petitioner shall be required to submit the compliance of this order.
