1. Learned counsel Ms. Aditi Sharma, appearing on behalf of the respondent-State, submits that certain encroachments exist over the Government pasture (Gochar) land situated in Village Tikhi Ka Badiya, Tehsil Kareda, District Bhilwara. It is submitted that the competent authorities have already initiated the process for removal of such encroachments and seeks some further time to place on record the progress made in that regard.
2. Mr. Rakesh Arora, learned counsel appearing for the private respondents, submits that the present Public Interest Litigation appears to have been directed only against three individuals, namely, Santosh Singh, Narain Singh and Tej Singh, whereas several other persons are also stated to be in occupation of the land in question. He, therefore, submits that the State ought to

verify not only whether the aforesaid three persons are encroachers upon the Government pasture land, but also ascertain the status of all other persons allegedly in occupation thereof.

3. In response, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the names of the aforesaid three persons have been taken from the official record annexed with the writ petition, particularly Annexure-5 (Page 41).

4. Replying thereto, learned counsel for the respondent-State submits that, upon verification, the encroachments have indeed been found to have been made by the aforesaid three persons. It is further submitted that complaints have already been registered against them and the authorities have initiated the necessary proceedings for removal of the encroachments.

5. In view of the aforesaid statement, it is directed that the encroachments made by the aforesaid three persons, whom the State has already ascertained to be encroachers upon the Gochar land, be removed, and a necessary progress report shall be filed by the next date of hearing. The State shall also be at liberty to remove any other encroachment found on the land in question.

6. List the matter after four weeks.
