1. The petitioner, is a principal of the Government Girls Sr. Sec School, Naurangdesar, District Hanumangarh, has filed a

complaint before the competent authority against some of the staff members of the school for their indecency and obesity before the minor students of the school. Therefore, such staff members became adamant and started to abuse, scuffle and threat her life.

2. The petitioner has filed a representation dated 05.05.2026 before the SHO of Police Station Hanumangarh seeking protection to her life and to take strict action against the named wrong doer.

3. After arguing the matter for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner made a limited prayer that the present writ be disposed of while directing the police authority to consider the representation of the petitioner and take appropriate action.

4. Taking into account all the facts and circumstances of the case, the petitioner is directed to submit a detailed representation before the concerned Superintendent of Police and the SHO of Police Station Hanumangarh within a period of two weeks from today, who shall take up all the facts as well as contentions raised in the representation and shall take appropriate action by considering them strictly in accordance with law.

5. The instant criminal writ petition is disposed of accordingly. Stay Petition also stands disposed of.
