1. Apprehending his arrest in connection with FIR No. 164/2025 registered at Police Station Nohar, District Hanumangarh for the offences under Sections 318(4) of BNS, Section 66-B of I.T. Act and Section 3 and 4 of Rajasthan Public Gambling Ordinance, 1949.
2. Learned counsel for the accused-petitioner submits that accused-petitioner has falsely been implicated in this case under Sections 318(4) of BNS, Section 66-B of I.T. Act and Section 3 and 4 of Rajasthan Public Gambling Ordinance, 1949. It is contended that the petitioner has joined the investigation and custodial interrogation qua the petitioner is not required, therefore, anticipatory bail application of the accused-petitioner may be allowed.
3. Learned Public Prosecutor submitted the factual report as per which, the petitioner has joined the investigation in compliance of the order dated 01.07.2025.

4. Heard and perused the material available on record.
5. Considering the arguments advanced by learned counsel for the petitioner and looking to the factual report and considering the fact that custodial interrogation of the petitioner is not required, , I deem it just and proper to allow the anticipatory bail application of the accused-petitioner.
6. Accordingly, the anticipatory bail application under Section 482 BNSS is allowed and it is ordered that in the event of arrest of the petitioner **Paras Bardiya S/o Shri Madan Lal Bardiya**, in connection with FIR No. 164/2025 registered at Police Station Nohar, District Hanumangarh he shall be released on bail, provided he furnishes a personal bond in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with two sureties in the sum of Rs.25,000/- each to the satisfaction of the S.H.O/I.O/Arresting Officer of the concerned Police Station on the following conditions:-
 - (i) that the petitioner shall make himself available for interrogation by a police officer as and when required;
 - (ii) that the petitioner shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade them from disclosing such facts to the court or any police officer, and
 - (iii) that the petitioner shall not leave India without previous permission of the court.
