Order

By way of filing the present writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, the petitioners have prayed for the following reliefs:

“It is, therefore, most respectfully prayed by the Petitioners before your kind Hon'ble Court that the writ petition filed by the

petitioners may kindly be allowed and by, an appropriate order or direction, in the nature thereof.

- (a) quash and set set aside the impugned Notice No 968 dated 19.05.2025 (Annx-1) issued by Respondent No 2 and the impugned Notices, No. 208, 209, 210 & 211 all dated 08.05 2025 (Annx-2), issued by Respondent No 4, as being arbitrary, illegal, and violative of the principles of natural Justice;*
- (b) direct the respondent authorities not to interfere in the lawful possession of the Petitioners on Khasra Nos 1089, 1090 & 1091 of Bhinmal-A and further restraining them from disconnecting the electricity supply of the Petitioners without following due process of law;*
- (c) any other appropriate order or direction, which this Hon'ble Court considers just and proper in the facts and circumstances of this case, may kindly be passed in favour of the member of Petitioners;*
- (d) cost of the writ petition may also be allowed in favour of the Petitioners."*

After hearing the learned counsel for the parties at the Bar, this Court deems it just and proper to dispose of the present writ petition with a direction to the petitioners to file a reply to the notice dated 19.05.2025 issued against them by the Executive Officer, Nagar Palika, Bhinmal, within a period of four weeks from today.

Upon receipt of the reply to the notice dated 19.05.2025, the Executive Officer, Nagar Palika, Bhinmal, shall consider the same sympathetically and objectively. Thereafter, a reasoned and speaking order shall be passed after due consideration of the grievances raised by the petitioners.

It is made clear that until the reply filed by the petitioners is considered and decided by the Executive Officer, Nagar Palika, Bhinmal, the effect and operation of the impugned notice dated 19.05.2025 shall remain stayed.
