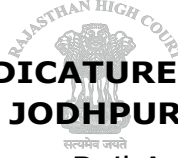

1. These bail applications under Section 483 of BNSS are filed by the applicants-accused **1. Sunil S/o Purna Ram, 2. Dulichand S/o Surjaram** seeking bail in respect of a criminal case registered as FIR No.53/2026 dated 09.02.2026 registered at P.S. Jai Narayan Vyas Colony,



District - Bikaner, for the offence under Sections 115(2), 126(2), 109(1), 324(4), 309(6), 3(5) of BNS.

2. Learned counsel for the applicants submits that the applicants have been falsely implicated in the matter and the investigation against them is complete and they are no more required in investigation. He further submits that there are no chance of fleeing of applicant accused from the jurisdiction of this Hon'ble Court. The applicants do not have any criminal antecedents. He also submits that the applicants undertakes not to repeat offence and cooperate with investigation/trial, which will take time.
3. Learned counsel for the applicants-accused submits that for incident of 08.02.2026 the report lodged by complainant Hetram on 09.02.2026 and during investigation police has arrested accused Sunil S/o Purnaram on 09.02.2026 and Dulichand on 09.02.2026. He also submitted that both the injured Radheshyam and Hetram were examined by Medical Jurist and after examination it was found that all the injuries are on non vital part. He further referred injury report and X-Ray report of Hetram and submitted that all injuries are simple in nature whereas two injuries of Radheshyam were found as grievous but both are on non vital parts. He also submitted that charge-sheet has already been filed.
4. Aforesaid contentions were opposed by learned counsel for the complainant and learned Public Prosecutor. Learned counsel for the complainant has submitted that both the injured were brutally assaulted by group of persons and both petitioners are involved in the incident.



5. Heard learned counsel for the parties and learned Public Prosecutor. Perused the material placed on record by both the parties.
6. On basis of a report dated 09.02.2026 lodged by Hetram against four named persons including both the petitioners FIR No.53/2026 was registered at Police Station Jai Narain Vyas Colony, District Bikaner. During investigation both the accused were arrested on 09.02.2026 and a charge-sheet is filed against four persons including present petitioners. The injury report indicate that Radheshyam has sustained two fractures on left knee and left leg with ankle whereas all injuries of Hetram are opined as simple, remaining injuries of Radheshyam are also opined as simple. There is no criminal antecedent against the petitioners.
7. Upon hearing the arguments and perusing the record, we have found that the applicants-accused are no more required in the investigation and they are in custody for quite some time. The further proceedings will take its own time, therefore, looking to entirety of facts and circumstances of the case and without expressing any opinion on merits of the case, the Court deems it appropriate to grant bail to the applicants-accused.
8. Thus, the instant bail applications filed on behalf of applicants-accused **1. Sunil S/o Purna Ram, 2. Dulichand S/o Surjaram**, are hereby allowed and the applicants-accused are ordered to be released on bail with condition that each of the petitioner would furnish a personal bond of



₹50,000/- with two sureties of like amount to the satisfaction of the Trial Court with the following conditions:-

- (i) The applicants-accused shall not tamper with evidence or influence the witness in any manner.
- (ii) The applicants-accused shall not indulge in any criminal activity and shall not repeat any criminal offence punishable under the Law.
- (iii) The applicants-accused shall attend the hearing of the Trial Court on the date fixed by the Trial court or as and when asked to appear before the Trial Court.
- (iv) In case of any violation of above conditions, the bail granted to the applicants-accused shall be liable to be canceled.
