This application for bail under Section 483 BNSS (439 Cr.P.C.) has been filed by the petitioner who has been arrested in connection with F.I.R. No.128/2025 registered at Police Station Kotwali, District Sirohi, for offences under Sections 319(2), 318(4) and 61(2) of BNS.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the allegation against the petitioner is that, upon being asked, he paid the amount and impersonated as Kalu Ram Dewasi. It is further submitted that the petitioner was arrested during the course of investigation and that the investigation qua the petitioner has been completed. It is further submitted that the offences alleged to have been committed by the petitioner are triable by the Court of Magistrate and that the petitioner has been in judicial custody

since 18.04.2026 and that the trial is likely to take a considerable amount of time to conclude. Therefore, it is prayed that the benefit of bail be granted to the accused-petitioner.

Per contra, learned Public Prosecutor has opposed the bail application.

Heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the material available on record.

This Court has considered the rival submissions and the offence pressed against the petitioner are triable by court of Magistrate. The allegations levelled against the petitioner are that, upon his asking, the amount was paid and that he impersonated one Kalu Ram Dewasi. The petitioner was arrested during the course of investigation and that the investigation qua the petitioner is complete. It is further submitted that the petitioner has been in judicial custody since 18.04.2026.

Hence, keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case; the alleged offences are triable by a Magistrate; keeping in view of the fact that conclusion of the trial of the case is likely to take time and the prosecution has not shown any apprehension of the petitioner fleeing away from justice, in case he is enlarged on bail; but, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I deem it just and proper to grant bail to the petitioner under Section 483 of BNSS.

Consequently, the bail application under Section 483 BNSS (439 Cr.P.C.) is allowed. It is ordered that the accused-petitioner **Raju Kumar Sargara S/o Chunnilal** arrested in connection with FIR No.128/2025 registered at Police Station Kotwali, District

Sirohi, shall be released on bail, if not wanted in any other case, provided he furnishes a personal bond of Rs.50,000/- and two sureties of Rs.25,000/- each, to the satisfaction of learned trial court, for his appearance before that court on each & every date of hearing and whenever called upon to do so till completion of the trial.
