The issue raised in the writ petition pertains to the re-grant/restoration of an electricity connection. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that a civil suit is *subjudice*, as on date, between the parties, wherein an application for temporary injunction under Order XXXIX Rules 1 and 2 of the Code of Civil Procedure has not yet been decided.

It is further submitted that the petitioner is in occupancy of the premises and that his fundamental rights are being infringed on account of the disconnection of the electricity supply. In the aforesaid facts and circumstances, it is submitted that the present writ petition is maintainable.
