1. This instant application under Section 482 BNSS, 2023 is filed by the petitioner-applicant **Mehrudeen S/o Sh. Peeru Khan** seeking bail in respect of a criminal case registered as FIR No.176/2000 dated 03.06.2000 registered at P.S. Deogarh, District - Rajsamand, for the offence under Sections 302 & 201 IPC.
2. During the course of arguments, learned counsel for the applicant submits that main Sessions Case No.91/2001 was disposed of by learned Addl. Sessions Judge (Fast Track) Rajsamand on 15.04.2002 whereby main accused Raju Das was convicted under Section 302 R/w 34, 120-B, 397 and 201 of IPC. He also submitted that applicant was later on

arrested and currently he is in custody. He further submitted that only on basis of interrogation note Ex.P/34 recorded by PW/24 Bhanwar Singh Chundawat of main accused Raju, the applicant was arrayed as an accused but there is no independent evidence neither recorded at the of previous charge-sheet nor after interrogation post arrest of present applicant. He offers to withdraw the bail application under Section 483 of the BNSS with liberty to file after recording the statement of PW/8 Raju Puri and PW/24 Bhanwar Singh Chundawat.

3. Hence, the instant bail application is hereby dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as aforesaid.
4. The Trial Court is directed to record statements of PW/8 Raju Puri and PW/24 Bhanwar Singh Chundawat on priority basis preferably within four months from the date of receipt copy of the order.
5. The Registry is directed to send a copy of this order to the Trial Court through E-mail.
