The present application for interim bail under Section 483 of the BNSS has been filed by the applicant seeking grant of interim bail on the ground of the medical condition of his wife. It is submitted that the applicant's wife is suffering from a serious uterine ailment and has been advised to undergo surgery at a higher medical centre. In support of the said contention, the applicant has placed on record a medical prescription/slip issued by the District Hospital, Chohtan, Barmer. It is further submitted that the presence of the applicant is necessary for facilitating the treatment and care of his wife. Therefore, the applicant has prayed that he be granted the benefit of interim bail.

Learned Public Prosecutor has produced the report of the District Hospital, Chohtan, Barmer, which verifies that the wife of

the applicant is suffering from a condition requiring vaginal hysterectomy and is in need of medical treatment.

In view of the medical documents placed on record, this Court finds that the wife of the applicant requires urgent treatment at a higher medical centre.

Looking to the facts and circumstances of the case, this Court deems it just and proper to grant interim bail to the accused-applicant for a period of 30 days so as to enable him to take the applicant's wife to a higher medical centre and ensure that she receives proper treatment.

Accordingly, the interim bail application filed under Section 483 of the BNSS is allowed. It is directed that the applicant, namely, **Om Prakash S/o Bhikaram**, arrested in connection with F.I.R. No. 46/2026 registered at Police Station Ramsar, District Barmer, for the offences under Sections 8/15 and 25 of the NDPS Act, shall be released on interim bail for a period of **30 days**, provided he furnishes a personal bond in the sum of **Rs.1,00,000/-** along with **two sound and solvent sureties** in the sum of **Rs.50,000/- each** (out of which one surety shall be a close relative of the applicant), to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court, for their surrender upon completion of **30 days** from the date of their actual release.

(i). the applicant shall surrender before the concerned jail authorities immediately upon expiry of the interim bail period of 30 days, unless the period is extended by a competent court;

(ii). the applicant shall neither tamper with the evidence in the matter, nor directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade them from

disclosing such facts to the Court or any Police Officer;

(iii). the applicant shall not leave the State of Rajasthan without prior permission of the Court concerned;

(iv). the applicant and the sureties of the applicant will keep their mobile phones in active mode and in case of change of their mobile numbers, intimation in this regard will be given to the Court concerned by way of an affidavit.

Let this bail application be again listed on 28.07.2026.

Learned Public Prosecutor shall be required to submit the compliance report of the order as to whether the applicant has surrendered or not.
