Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is a travel agent. It is submitted that the complainant had processed his papers through the petitioner for travelling to Australia. However, thereafter, the complainant informed the petitioner that he was no longer intending to travel, whereupon the petitioner agreed to refund the amount received. It is further submitted that, during the process of refunding the amount, the present FIR came to be lodged. Learned counsel submits that the petitioner has never denied his liability to refund the amount. Thus, it is contended that the dispute essentially pertains to a monetary transaction and does not attract any criminal liability.

In view of the aforesaid submissions, this Court is inclined to interfere in the matter.

List the matter after six weeks.

In the meanwhile, the petitioner shall not be arrested in connection with **FIR No. 348/2026**, registered at Police Station Hanumangarh Junction, District Hanumangarh. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when required by the Investigating Officer.
