1. Heard learned counsel for the parties.
2. The present Habeas Corpus Petition has been filed by the
petitioner who is the father of the corpus Mst. 'R' who is stated to
be in illegal detention of some person.

3. In pursuance of the directions issued by this Court, the corpus Mst. 'R' has been produced before us.

4. We have conferred with the corpus Mst. 'R'. The corpus Mst. 'R' has stated that she is 20 years of age and has completed her studies uptill Senior Secondary. She has expressed her desire to continue her studies after 12th standard. She has secured above 90% marks in 12th standard. She has further stated that she is living with Mr. Sadiq of her own free will, without any pressure from any side. She has also stated that she is not in the illegal detention of any person. She has firmly stated before us that she is not interested in meeting with her parents, who are present in the Court. She also stated that her educational documents, which are lying at Shri Ram Senior Secondary School, Cherai, may be directed to be handed over to her for completing her further studies. She further stated that her parents along with Mr. Kishna Ram threatened her of dire consequences, if she continues to live with the person namely Mr. Sadiq. She has requested for providing adequate security to her till she reaches the place of her residence.

5. We have considered the submissions made at the bar and the statements made by the corpus Mst. 'R' before us.

6. We feel that the corpus Mst. 'R' is a major and educated lady, capable of taking her own decision judiciously. Since, the corpus has decided to go and live with Mr. Sadiq of her own free will and volition, therefore, she is not in illegal detention of any person.

7. In view of the statement made by the corpus Mst. 'R' before us, the present Habeas Corpus Petition is disposed of with a direction to the investigating agency to see to it that the corpus



Mst. 'R' reaches the place of her residence safely. It is also made clear that the petitioner shall not cause any harm to the corpus and Mr. Sadiq.
