1. This application has been filed by the petitioner seeking extension of time for filing representation as granted in the order dated 07.05.2026.
2. Vide order dated 07.05.2026, this Court has directed the petitioner to file representation ventilating his grievances before respondent – Authority within a period of 10 days from the date of passing of this order and further directed the respondent - Authority to decide the representation in accordance with law within a period of 45 days from the date of receipt of the order.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that due to inadvertence and miscommunication the representation could not be filed by the petitioner within the stipulated time i.e. 10 days from the date of passing of said order.

4. Learned counsel thus, prayed that the period to file representation before the concerned authority may be extended.

5. Mr. N. S. Rajpurohit, learned Additional Advocate General does not dispute the genuine prayer of learned counsel for the petitioner.

6. Having heard learned counsel for the parties and considered the reasons stated in the application, this Court deems it just and proper to allow the present application.

7. It is thus, directed that the period of filing representation before the respondent – Authority granted to the present petitioner vide order 07.05.2026 is extended for 15 days from the date of passing of this order.

8. It is expected from the concerned respondent – Authority that if any representation is filed, the same shall be decided as expeditiously as possible, preferably within a period of 45 days from the date of receipt of representation.

9. Accordingly, the present application is disposed of.
