1. The present bail application under Section 483 of BNSS is filed by the applicant-accused **Smt. Jasu Kanwar W/o Kump Singh @ Sawai Singh** seeking bail in respect of a criminal case registered as FIR No.34/2026 dated 08.05.2026 registered at Police Station Sankra, District Jaisalmer, for the offence under Sections 333, 87 and 3(5) of BNS, 2023.
2. Learned counsel for the applicant submits that the applicant has been falsely implicated in the matter and the investigation against her is complete and she is no more

required in investigation. He further submits that there are no chance of fleeing of applicant-accused from the jurisdiction of this Hon'ble Court. He also submits that the applicant undertakes not to repeat offence and cooperate with trial, which will take time.

3. Learned counsel for the applicant submits that the applicant-accused is a female and she is in custody since her arrest. He also submitted that the main allegation is upon Kump Singh @ Sawai Singh and recovery of sharp edged weapon is effected from him only. He also submitted that present applicant-accused has been arrayed as an accused with help of Section 3(5) of BNS and there is no criminal antecedents against her.
4. Aforesaid contentions were opposed by learned Public Prosecutor and he submitted that the offence is serious in nature and role and involvement of applicant is established from the material on record.
5. Heard learned counsel for the applicant-accused and learned Public Prosecutor. Perused the material placed on record by both the parties.
6. On basis of a complaint dated 08.05.2026 by Jamna Kanwar against Sawai Singh and present applicant-accused FIR No. 34/2026 under Section 333, 87 and 3(5) of BNS was registered at P.S. Sankra, District Jaisalmer on 08.05.2026. During investigation present applicant-accused was arrested and she is in custody since her arrest. The main allegation is on Kump Singh @ Sawai Singh as a sword has been

recovered at his instance. The applicant-accused is a female and she has been charged with aid of Section 3(5) of BNS.

7. This Court also finds that the applicant-accused has remained in custody for a considerable period of time and that the trial/proceedings are likely to take further time to conclude. Therefore, looking to the entirety of the facts and circumstances of the case and without expressing any opinion on the merits thereof, this Court deems it appropriate to grant bail to the applicant-accused.
8. Thus, the instant bail application filed on behalf of applicant-accused **Smt. Jasu Kanwar W/o Kump Singh @ Sawai Singh**, is hereby allowed and the applicant-accused is ordered to be released on bail upon furnishing a personal bond of ₹50,000/- with two sureties of like amount to the satisfaction of the Trial Court with the following conditions:-
 - (i) The applicant-accused shall not tamper with evidence or influence the witness in any manner.
 - (ii) The applicant-accused shall not indulge in any criminal activity and shall not repeat any criminal offence punishable under the Law.
 - (iii) The applicant-accused shall attend the hearing of the Trial Court on the date fixed by the Trial court or as and when asked to appear before the Trial Court.
 - (iv) In case of any violation of above conditions, the bail granted to the applicant-accused shall be liable to be canceled.
