This application for bail under Section 483 of BNSS has been filed by the petitioner who has been arrested in connection with F.I.R. No.195/2026 registered at Police Station New Mandi, Gharsana, District Sri Ganganagar, for offences under Sections 8/15 and 25 of the NDPS Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that, in the present case, a recovery of 24.8 kg of *Doda Post* was effected from the main accused, namely, Dinesh Kumar and Ramesh. He further submits that the petitioner has been implicated solely on the basis of the statements made by the co-accused, wherein he has been alleged to be the supplier of the contraband. It is contended that the quantity of contraband recovered is below the commercial quantity prescribed under the NDPS Act. Learned counsel further submits that the petitioner has been in judicial custody since 22.05.2026 and that the conclusion of the trial is

likely to take a considerable period of time. Therefore, it is prayed that the benefit of bail be granted to the accused-petitioner.

Per contra, learned Public Prosecutor has opposed the bail application.

Having heard and considered the rival submissions, facts and circumstances of the case as well as perused the material available on record; considering the fact that the narcotic contraband recovered in this case is below commercial quantity; the petitioner is in judicial custody since 22.05.2026 and the present recovery is made from the main accused Dinesh Kumar and Ramesh of 24.8 Kgs of *Doda Post*; the investigation/trial will take sufficient time to conclude; without expressing any opinion on merits/demerits of the case, this Court is inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail.

Consequently, the bail application under Section 483 BNSS is allowed. It is ordered that the accused-petitioner **Rajuram S/o Surajaram** arrested in connection with FIR No.195/2026 registered at Police Station New Mandi, Gharsana, District Sri Ganganagar, shall be released on bail, if not wanted in any other case, provided he furnishes a personal bond of Rs.1,00,000/- and two sureties of Rs.50,000/- each, to the satisfaction of learned trial court, for his appearance before that court on each & every date of hearing and whenever called upon to do so till completion of the trial.
