In course of hearing, it has transpired that the appellant and the respondent were previously engaged in business or under private service. According to the learned counsel for the appellant-husband, presently, the husband is not in job. This Court has also been informed that the wife was doing some private job and engaged in some private business at Gandhinagar where she met the appellant and their marriage was solemnized on 28th November 2017.

2. Mr. Jubin Mehta, the learned counsel for the appellant, on instructions, submits that the appellant is ready and willing to receive his wife in the matrimonial home and keep her with all comfort and dignity. However, he has apprehension because in

course of mediation his wife refused to come back to the matrimonial home. The learned counsel for the appellant further submits that the wife of the appellant has taken out multiple proceedings against him including filing of criminal complaint/FIR.

3. This matter was taken up for hearing in the morning and the learned counsels appearing for the parties were instructed to seek instructions from their respective clients.

4. After the recess, Mr. Shamboo Singh Rathore, the learned counsel for the respondent informs the Court that the respondent is ready and willing to join the company of her husband at Udaipur.

5. Having regard to the statements made, on instructions, by the learned counsels appearing for the parties, we see a ray of hope of mediation and reconciliation between the parties. Therefore, the parties are directed to appear before Mr. Dilip Singh Udawat, the learned Mediator at the Mediation Center, Jodhpur on 18th September 2024 at 12:00 PM in the premises of The Rajasthan High Court Building, Jhalamand Jodhpur. On that day, the appellant shall pay Rs.10,000/- to his wife in presence of the Mediator for the traveling and lodging expenses.
