1. This second application for bail under Section 483 BNSS has been filed by the petitioner who has been arrested in connection with F.I.R. No.136/2022 registered at Police Station Shivganj (Erinpura), District Sirohi, for the offences under Sections 366, 342, 376 and 376(2)(n) of IPC.
2. None present for the petitioner.
3. The present bail application has been pending before this Court since 05.08.2023. On the previous two dates of hearing, i.e., 17.11.2023 and 19.12.2025, none appeared on behalf of the petitioner.
4. In the aforesaid circumstances, this Court has perused the case file with the assistance of the learned Public Prosecutor. From a perusal of the record, it transpires that, as per the prosecution case, the victim 'H', who is deaf and mute, was forcibly taken away by the petitioner on his motorcycle. Some villagers informed

the complainant about the said incident. Thereafter, the complainant, along with villagers namely Sharwan, Pabba Ram, etc., commenced a search for the victim 'H'. Upon reaching a secluded place near Khandra Road (Banka Nadi), they allegedly found the victim being subjected to forcible sexual assault by the present petitioner.

5. This Court, having considered the medical examination report of the victim 'H' and the statements of various witnesses, including the complainant, Pabba Ram and Sharwan Kumar, and further keeping in view the seriousness and gravity of the allegations levelled against the petitioner, is not inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail.

6. Consequently, the present bail application is rejected. However, the present order shall not preclude the petitioner from filing a fresh bail application, if occasion so arise.
