Counsel for the petitioner submits that the respondents are holding interviews for the post of College Librarian from 22.6.2026 to 25.6.2026, however, the petitioner is being denied from participating in the ongoing interviews on the ground of not having "good academic record", whereas the circular defining the same stands partially withdrawn.

Counsel for the petitioner has relied upon the order dated 21.04.2026 passed by Co-ordinate Bench of this Court at Jaipur in S.B. Civil Writ Petition No.6722/2026, wherein candidates have provisionally been permitted to appear in the interview. The order reads thus :-

"Issue notice(s) to the respondent Nos. 1, 2 and 3, returnable within three weeks.

Mr. M.F. Baig, Adv. appears for Rajasthan Public Service Commission-respondent No.4.

Service of respondent No.4 is complete.

Learned counsel for respondent No.4 submits that the same controversy was examined by the Co-ordinate Bench of this Court in S.B. CWP No.15690/2023 in the case of Deepak Kumar Bansal Versus State of Rajasthan and other connected petitions S.B. CWP No. 15615/2023, S.B. CWP No. 17383/ 2023, S.B. CWP No. 18490/2023 and S.B. CWP No.240/ 2024 vide order dated 27.05.2025.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in the case of Deepak Kumar Bansal (supra), the Co-ordinate Bench of this Court by way of an interim order permitted the candidates to appear in the interview, thus, he prays for grant of similar relief in the instant case.

In view of the interim order passed by the Co-ordinate Bench of this Court in Deepak Kumar Bansal (supra), the respondents are directed to permit the petitioner to provisionally appear in the interview, however, result of the same shall be kept in a sealed cover and will remain subject to the outcome of this writ petition.

List this case along with S.B. CWP No.15690/2023.

Name of Mr. M.F. Baig, Adv. be shown in the cause-list as counsel for the respondent No.4."

In view of the same, this Court is inclined to interfere.

Issue notice. Issue notice of stay application also, returnable within a period of four weeks.

Meanwhile, the respondents are directed to permit the petitioner to provisionally appear in the interview, however, result



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of the same shall be kept in a sealed cover and will remain subject to the outcome of this writ petition.
