1. Learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that the issue involved in this writ petition is identical to one in which interim order was passed by this Court on 23.05.2025.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that the petitioners have already preferred objections before the concerned District Collector and they must have been forwarded to the three Member High Level Committee constituted by the State Government on 10.01.2025. He prayed that interim order similar to the order dated 23.05.2025 be passed in the present case as well.

3. Mr. I.R. Choudhary, learned Additional Advocate General submitted that so far as the objections are concerned, the State will consider the same in some time, but no interim order be passed.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioners, at this juncture, submitted that the State has no urgency as of now, because the date fixed for freezing the administrative boundaries of the village for the purpose of census has been extended upto 31.12.2025.

5. Having heard learned counsel for the parties and considering that there is no hurry as such in creation of the village/panchayat boundaries, this Court is persuaded to pass the similar interim order as has been passed in the bunch of writ petitions led by *S.B. Civil Writ Petition No.8576/2025 : Dhanna Ram & Ors. Vs. State of Rajasthan & Ors.*

6. Meanwhile, the competent high-level Committee of the State is directed to consider the objections relating the present writ petition so also the similar matters, list whereof shall be supplied to them by the office of Advocate General. While doing so, the Committee shall decide the proposals so sent by the Collectors in terms of the Guidelines dated 10.01.2025 and other guidelines issued from time to time so also the issues/questions, which this Court has highlighted hereinabove.
