This application for bail under Section 483 BNSS (439 Cr.P.C.) has been filed by the petitioner who has been arrested in connection with F.I.R. No.26/2026 registered at Police Station Sadar District Hanumangarh, for offences under Sections 318(4) and 316(2) of BNS.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he is only a witness to the alleged agreement. He submits that he is behind the bars since 20.05.2026 and investigating from the petitioner is complete and the offences alleged to have been committed by the petitioner are triable by court of Magistrate and the trial of the case will take sufficiently long time, therefore, the benefit of bail may be granted to the accused-petitioner.

Per contra, learned Public Prosecutor has opposed the bail application.

This Court has considered the rival submissions and perused the material available on record. The petitioner is only a witness to the alleged agreement. He is behind the bars since 20.05.2026 and investigating from the petitioner is complete. The alleged offences pressed against the petitioner are triable by court of Magistrate.

Hence, keeping in view of the fact that conclusion of the trial of the case is likely to take time and the prosecution has not shown any apprehension of the petitioner fleeing away from justice, in case he is enlarged on bail; but, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I deem it just and proper to grant bail to the petitioner under Section 483 of BNSS.

Consequently, the bail application under Section 483 BNSS (439 Cr.P.C.) is allowed. It is ordered that the accused-petitioner **Chetram S/o Shri Krishnalal** arrested in connection with FIR No.26/2026 registered at Police Station Sadar Hanumangarh, shall be released on bail, if not wanted in any other case, provided he furnishes a personal bond of Rs.50,000/- and two sureties of Rs.25,000/- each, to the satisfaction of learned trial court, for his appearance before that court on each & every date of hearing and whenever called upon to do so till completion of the trial.
