1. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that present is the second round of litigation.
2. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner has relied upon (Annexure-1) order dated 01.06.2026, more specifically Annexure-1 whereby the competent authority without analyzing the data/ submissions of the petitioner, in a cryptic manner has arrived at a conclusion. It is contended that the petitioner-association is engaged in manufacture of modules, used in a solar panel. It is further submitted that in solar panel, there are two raw materials/inputs; first module which is manufactured by the petitioner herein and other product is PV Cell which is primarily manufactured by members of Indian Solar Manufactures Association.

3. Further, it is submitted that an uncalled and unreasonable, restriction has been imposed upon him by way of impugned office memorandum to purchase the PV Cells from members of impleaded association and other related members. It is further submitted that the cut-off date i.e. 01.06.2026 was introduced and the same is highly arbitrary; and violative of Articles 14 and 19(1)(g) of the Constitution of India. It is also submitted that on account of price, quality, inadequate capacity and supply, the petitioners' manufacturing operations will suffer and he will be an alien in the market; moreover, the petitioner shall also not be able to support and maintain its infrastructure and cater the needs of its members.

4. Today, when the matter is called, reply and the list of members of the association is not placed on record.

5. Considering the facts of the case, this Court directs that requisites be carried out; and also directs Union of India that considering the seriousness, technicality in the matter, to call for issuing and undersigning authority of Annexure-1 i.e. notifications dated 01.06.2026 and 25.05.2026, before this Court, along with records by which present policy decision was taken.
