1. Shri Bharat Vyas, learned Additional Solicitor General, and Mr. Balbir Singh, learned Senior Counsel appearing for respondent No. 2, submit that in view of recent developments, the *lis* involved in the present writ petition has been reduced to academic importance.
2. It is apprised to this Court that upon a review by the Union of India, the respondents have taken a conscious decision on 18.07.2026, whereby the impugned memorandum dated

25.05.2026 has been kept in abeyance for a period of the next seven months.

3. Learned counsel for the respondents submit that in light of this subsequent development, prayer (c) of the writ petition, which seeks the provision of a reasonable transition period, stands substantially addressed. It is further submitted that they have no objection if the petitioner is granted liberty to agitate any surviving grievances, if any arise.

4. Mr. Acharya, learned Senior Counsel appearing for the petitioner, submits that a copy of the application/decision detailing these subsequent developments was supplied to him only during the course of the day. He prays for a short accommodation to seek instructions.

5. The concerned Officer, pursuant to earlier directions, has marked his attendance before the Court. In view of the subsequent developments noted above, his further personal appearance, as well as the requirement to produce the relevant records, is hereby dispensed with.

6. List the matter on 22.07.2026 in the supplementary cause list.
