1. Learned counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* contends that there is a colossal delay in registration of the FIR, at the instance of the complainant-Company, inasmuch as, the accident in question took place in the year 2018, and the FIR, where the petitioner has been implicated was registered on 31.03.2023, as a counter-blast, to evade the financial liability, which has been fastened on the Insurance Company by virtue of the award given to the victims by the Motor Accidents Claims Tribunal (MACT).
2. Issue notice.
3. Learned Public Prosecutor accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.1 - State. Let notice be issued to respondent No.2.
4. Learned Public Prosecutor seeks time to file a report.



5. Meanwhile, no coercive steps shall be taken against the petitioners qua the FIR in question. However, petitioners shall join the investigation as and when summoned by the Investigating Officer.
