This application for bail under Section 483 of BNSS has been filed by the petitioner who has been arrested in connection with FIR No.122/2026 registered at Police Station Pachpadra, District Balotra, for offences under Sections 143(2), 143(3), 144(2) and 111(3) of BNS and Sections 3, 4 and 5 of Immoral Traffic Prevention Act.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned Public Prosecutor. Perused the material available on record.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the offences pressed against the petitioner are triable by Magistrate. It is further alleged that the petitioner is only a customer in spa centre and there is no direct involvement has been found. Petitioner is behind the bars since 27.05.2026 and the investigation from the petitioner is complete; the trial of the case will take sufficiently

long time, therefore, the benefit of bail may be granted to the accused-petitioner.

Per contra, learned Public Prosecutor has opposed the bail application.

Heard the rival submissions and considered the facts and circumstances of the case. The offences alleged to have been committed by the petitioner are triable by Court of Magistrate and he is in judicial custody since 27.05.2026. Keeping in view the fact that conclusion of the trial of the case is likely to take sufficient long time and the prosecution has not shown any apprehension of the petitioner fleeing away from justice, in case he is enlarged on bail; but, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I deem it just and proper to grant bail to the petitioner under Section 483 of BNSS.

Consequently, the bail application under Section 483 of BNSS is allowed. It is ordered that the accused-petitioner **Shravan Kumar S/o Kanaram** arrested in connection with FIR No.122/2026 registered at Police Station Pachpadra, District Balotra, shall be released on bail, if not wanted in any other case, provided he furnishes a personal bond of Rs.50,000/- and two sureties of Rs.25,000/- each, to the satisfaction of learned trial court, for his appearance before that court on each & every date of hearing and whenever called upon to do so till completion of the trial.
