The present interim bail application under Section 483 BNSS has been filed by the applicant on the ground that surgery of father of the applicant. The medical documents of the same has been placed on record.

Learned Public Prosecutor has submitted the verification report dated 23.06.2026, as per which after constitution of medical board the patient has been referred to higher medical center, and the surgery is stated to be fixed on 02.07.2026 as per the patient record at the District Hospital, Neemach.

In view of the fact, certainly the applicant deserves to be granted interim bail.

Looking to the facts and circumstances of the case, this Court deems it just and proper to grant interim bail to the accused-applicant for a period **20 days**.

Accordingly, the interim bail application filed under Section 483 BNSS is allowed and it is directed that applicant **Ishwar Singh @ Hariom Singh S/o Shri Akshay Singh Rajput** arrested in connection with F.I.R. No.232/2025 registered at Police Station Kotwali, District Chittorgarh for the offences under Sections 103(1), 115(2), 190, 191(2)(3), 238A, 324(5), 326(F), 333, 111(2)(1)/61(2)(A) BNS and 3/25 and 4/25 of Arms Act, be released on interim bail for a period of **20 days**, provided he furnishes a personal bond in a sum of **Rs.1,00,000/-** with two sound and solvent sureties in the sum of **Rs.50,000/- (out of which one surety will be a close relative of the applicant)** each to the satisfaction of learned trial court for his surrender on completion of 20 days from the date of actual release.

- (i). the applicant shall surrender before the concerned jail authorities immediately upon expiry of the interim bail period of 20 days, unless the period is extended by a competent court;
- (ii). the applicant shall neither tamper with the evidence in the matter, nor directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade them from disclosing such facts to the Court or any Police Officer;
- (iii). the applicant shall not leave the State of Rajasthan without prior permission of the Court concerned;
- (iv). the applicant and the sureties of the applicant will keep their mobile phones in active mode and in case of change of their mobile numbers, intimation in this regard will be given to the Court concerned by way of an affidavit.

Let this bail application be again listed on 16.07.2026.
Learned Public Prosecutor shall be required to submit the
compliance report of the order as to whether the applicant has
surrendered or not.
