The present interim bail application under Section 483 BNSS has been filed by the petitioner, who is in custody in connection with FIR No.27/2025 registered at Police Station Napasar, District Bikaner for the offence punishable under Sections 8/18, 25 of the NDPS Act.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner's daughter, aged ten years, is suffering from severe burn eye problem and as per the medical reports, she has been advised to undergo surgery on 26.09.2025. In such circumstances, it is prayed that the petitioner may be released on interim bail on humanitarian ground.

3. Learned Public Prosecutor has opposed the interim bail of the accused-petitioner.

4. Perused the material made available to this Court including the medical documents placed on record by the learned counsel for the petitioner, as per which, the petitioner's daughter has been advised to undergo surgery on 26.09.2025. In such circumstances and taking a humanitarian view of the matter, this Court deems it fit to grant indulgence of temporary bail of **30 days** to the petitioner.

5. Accordingly, the interim bail application filed under Section 483 of B.N.S.S. is allowed and it is directed that petitioner **Ramesh S/o Shri Bhakar Ram**, arrested in connection with **FIR No.27/2025 registered at Police Station Napasar, District Bikaner** for the offence under Sections 8/18, 25 of the NDPS Act be released on interim bail for a period of **30 days**, subject to the condition that he shall deposit a sum of Rs.3,00,000/- before the trial Court and provided he furnishes a personal bond in a sum of Rs.1,00,000/- with two sound and solvent sureties in the sum of Rs.50,000/- (out of which one surety will be a close relative of the petitioner) each to the satisfaction of learned trial Court for his surrender on completion of **30 days** from the date of actual release.

6. If the petitioner surrenders within the stipulated period before the concerned Jail, then the amount of Rs.3,00,000/- deposited by the petitioner before the trial Court shall be refunded back to him whereas if the petitioner fails to surrender within the stipulated period, then the amount so deposited shall be forfeited immediately.



7. Let the bail application be again listed on 17.10.2025. Learned Public Prosecutor shall be required to submit the compliance report of the order as to whether the petitioner has surrendered or not.
