The present interim bail application under Section 483 of BNSS (439 Cr.P.C.) has been filed by the petitioner on the ground that his real brother has expired on 28.05.2026 and his presence is required for performing last rites and rituals of his brother. Copies of relevant documents in regard to death of petitioner's brother has also been placed on record.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the presence of petitioner is essential in order to perform the last rites and rituals of his brother. It is therefore, prayed that the petitioner may be released on interim bail for a period of two months.

Learned Public Prosecutor has not disputed the factum of petitioner's brother passing away.

Looking to the totality of facts and circumstances of the case, a humanitarian approach is required to be adopted, thus,

this Court deems it just and proper to enlarge the petitioner on interim bail for a period of **twelve days**.

Accordingly, the interim bail application filed under Section 483 of BNSS (439 Cr.P.C.) is allowed and it is directed that petitioner **Yadvindra Singh S/o Shri Kala Singh** arrested in connection with F.I.R. No.791/2023, registered at Police Station Hanumangarh Town, District Hanumangarh, for the offences under Sections 302, 460 & 34 of IPC, be released on interim bail for a period of **twelve (12) days**, provided he furnishes a personal bond in a sum of **Rs.4,00,000/-** with two sound and solvent sureties in the sum of **Rs.2,00,000/- (out of which one surety will be a close relative of the petitioner)** each to the satisfaction of learned trial court for his surrender on completion of **12 days** from the date of actual release.

Let this bail application be again listed on 24.07.2026. Learned Public Prosecutor shall be required to submit the compliance report of the order as to whether the petitioner has surrendered or not.
