Order

1. These bail applications under Section 483 of BNSS are filed
by the applicants-accused **Surya S/o Laxman** and
Manpreet Singh Alias Manu S/o Niranjn Singh seeking

bail in respect of a criminal case registered as FIR No. 171 dated 02.04.2026 registered at P.S. Suratgarh, District Ganga Nagar, for the offence under Sections 115(2), 126(2) and 189(2) BNS.

2. Learned counsel for the applicants submits that the applicants have been falsely implicated in the matter and the investigation against them is complete and they are no more required in investigation. He further submits that there are no chance of fleeing of applicants-accused from the jurisdiction of this Hon'ble Court. He also submits that the applicants undertake not to repeat offence and cooperate with investigation/trial, which will take time.
3. Learned counsel for petitioners while referring order dated 03.06.2026 in bail application No. 6697/2026 has submitted that the specific allegation for causing injury on the head of victim/injured was leveled against co-accused Aakash and no specific attribution is made upon any of the petitioners. He further submitted that on basis of investigation the bail of Deepak was granted by a Coordinate Bench and case of both the petitioners is identically placed with Deepak and they are entitled to get bail on ground of parity.
4. Learned Public Prosecutor has vehemently opposed the bail applications and submitted that the allegations are grave and serious in nature.
5. Heard learned counsel for the petitioners-accused and learned Public Prosecutor. Perused the material placed on record by both the parties.

6. On 02.04.2026 complainant Bhagirath has lodged a report about incident of assault on 01.04.2026 against 5 named and other un-named persons resulting in injuries upon him. After registration of FIR, the matter is investigated. Both the petitioners were arrested and they are in custody. A Coordinate Bench has allowed bail application of Deepak on 03.06.2026 and observed as under:-

"On perusal of case diary, it is revealed that specific allegation for causing injury on the head of victim/injured was leveled against the co-accused Aakash whereas it was stated in relation to the applicant that applicant along with two other persons have attacked with fist and belt. Medical report shows that injury caused to complainant was of simple nature and one injury was of grievous nature, which was caused by co-accused Aakash and not by applicant."

7. Upon hearing the arguments and perusing the record, we have found that the applicants-accused are no more required in the investigation and they are in custody for quite some time. The further proceedings will take its own time, therefore, looking to entirety of facts and circumstances of the case and without expressing any opinion on merits of the case, the Court deems it appropriate to grant bail to the applicants-accused.
8. Thus, the instant bail application filed on behalf of applicant-accused **Surya S/o Laxman** and **Manpreet Singh Alias Manu S/o Niranjan Singh**, are hereby allowed and the applicants-accused are ordered to be released on bail upon furnishing a personal bond of ₹50,000/- with two sureties of

like amount to the satisfaction of the Trial Court by each of the petitioner with the following conditions:-

- (i) The applicants-accused shall not tamper with evidence or influence the witness in any manner.
- (ii) The applicants-accused shall not indulge in any criminal activity and shall not repeat any criminal offence punishable under the Law.
- (iii) The applicants-accused shall attend the hearing of the Trial Court on the date fixed by the Trial court or as and when asked to appear before the Trial Court.
- (iv) In case of any violation of above conditions, the bail granted to the applicants-accused shall be liable to be canceled.
